General Requirements

The foundation for many of our rules is simple — be a good neighbor. If you tend your plot conscientiously, by Keeping it well weeded and harvested, you will make an invaluable contribution to the “community” which is at the heart of our garden.



Plot fees must be paid before planting.

There is no smoking or alcohol on any of the complex property.

No pets are allowed in the gardens.

Please use radios/players only with earphones.

Please monitor children at the gardens so that they do not damage neighbors' plot.

Plot Composition and Design

Tall crops should be planted toward the center of your garden plot where they will not cast shade to others plots.

Structures (trellises, hoops, fences, supports) should be at least one foot inside the plot edges.

Pressure - treated or other treated or painted wood may not be used in the plots.

Plot Composition and Design

Plots need to be well-tended throughout the season. Including weeding and harvesting of vegetables.

Acceptable mulching materials are: straw, wood chips , weed barrier mats.

Any tools used that belong to the MFCCG must be returned to the shed.

About our Property

The Morrell Family donated 21 acres of land to the Town of Bartlett in 2011 for the use of recreation. From then till now Bartlett Athletic & Recreation Association known to you all as Bartlett Recreation has been fundraising and writing grants for the first phase of the property.

We have 63 raised garden beds, with tool shed, tools watering ability. All beds are raised for easy access for everyone. We will strive to make it affordable for anyone who wants to grow their own fresh vegetables.

This portion of the property provides other recreational opportunities. There is a picnic pavilion complete with table and grill.

A fitness / nature walking trail with 10 fitness stations.

The Children of Josiah Bartlett Elementary School will mark the trail with species of trees and flowers.
