# **Community Garden Rules**

## **Introduction**

- The MFCCG is an endeavor focused on making vegetable garden beds available to all. We would like to offer garden plots to organizations and families in need as well as the general public. The MFCCG is located on a large parcel of land that was donated to the Town of Bartlett and fundraised entirely by Bartlett Recreation.
- Growing practices: Gardeners should avoid toxic chemicals on their plants. They are encouraged to use animal or vegetable fertilizers rather than synthetics, using natural pest controls instead of industrial insecticides, common planting and attractants to control pests.

## **Fees**

All beds are approximately 4 ' x 12 ' and come in a 1 foot, 2 foot or 3 foot in height.  
Cost \$35 each or 2 for \$60. There are NO refunds.

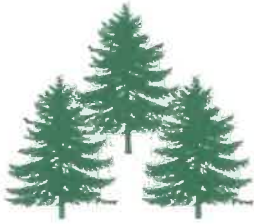
- Garden Fees help cover the expenses. The fee is due with the completion of the registration form. You should budget to cover the cost of seeds and seedlings, and organic/ natural soil additives that might be needed as well as any other supplies needed to grow your plants.

## **What is provided by MFCCG**

- The garden bed size you have selected.
- Unimproved topsoil to fill the raised bed.
- Water Source from a wellhead pump.
- Basic Gardening tools { rakes, shovels, wheelbarrow, etc.} that will be returned to the storage shed after use. You're welcome to bring your own tools and even donate your unwanted items.
- Communal storage for extra harvest to be donated to local food pantries.
- Composter for the disposal of weeds and clippings.
- An environment in which rules will be applied to everyone for the benefit of the garden as a whole.

## **Plot renter's commitment**

Gardening requires an investment of time and energy. In the early part of the season, it may be limited to opening the plot, getting it ready for planting {group work time} and then watering the soil as needed. As time goes on, the plot needs to be weeded, plants need to be thinned, pinched, pruned back as needed, possibly staked and nurtured. Throughout the season, sick plants are to be removed and properly disposed of, bugs removed, the plot watered regularly as needed, crops harvested, and fallen/ overripe/

damaged crops removed. The time you need to put into your plot will vary with the plants you choose to grow. It is important that you take care of your plot and plants... both for the health of the plants and the overall wellbeing of the garden.

This is a CARRY IN CARRY OUT facility.

### **Rules and Expectations**

- Pets are not permitted in the garden area.
- Personal music devices with headphones are permitted- no audible music.
- Children attending with you should be careful of other garden plots and not disturb them.
- Smoking and Alcohol is not permitted on any portion of the Morrell Family Community Complex.
- You are expected to participate in spring and fall prep and cleanup.
- Help neighbors if you can. Ask for help if you need it.
- There is a \$25 charge if we must clean out the bed at the end of the season.
